#### **Class 1 Prelim 14 (2006)**

*Open to horses with no more than 20 British Dressage points*

#### **Class 2 Novice 27 (2007)**

*Open to horses with no more than 74 British Dressage points*

#### **Class 3 Riding Test 6 (2005) Qualifier (Round 1)**

*Open to **all members** of Affiliated Riding Clubs who are either under 18 yrs old with horses who have no more than 5 BD points or members aged 18 and over with horses who have no more than 60 BD points. Riders not to have gained FBHS, BHSI, BHSII, BHSAI or pony club A test within the last ten years. **Juniors and Seniors will be judged separately in Class 3 & 4 ie: there will be 6 juniors & 6 seniors in total who qualify from Class 3 & 4.***

#### **Class 4 Riding Test 6 (2005) Qualifier (Round 1)**

*Open to all riders who are **not members** of an Affiliated Riding Club. Restrictions as Class 3 above.*

#### **Class 5 Elementary 44 (2002)**

*Open to horses with no more than 149 British Dressage points*

#### **Class 6 Combined Elementary 50 (2007) and Medium 63 (2002)**

*Open to horses with no more than 249 British Dressage points  
Same horse and rider combination are not permitted to ride in both the Elementary 50 and Medium 63. Please state on entry which test*

Riding Test Qualifier: 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Place qualifies for round 2. Competitors need not be members of an Affiliated Riding Club to compete in Round 1, but will need to join one before they can proceed to round 2, should they qualify. Horses need not be vaccinated against Equine Influenza for round 1, but must have received their first two injections before they can enter Round 2 and the finals at Royal Windsor Horse Show. None of the injections must have been given within the preceding 7 days, including the day of the competition.
