Class 1 Prelim 10 (2002) *Open to horses with no more than 20 BD Points*

Class 2 Prelim 14 (2006) *Open to horses with no more than 45 BD Points*

Class 3 Riding Test 6 (2005) Qualifier (Round 1)

Open to all members & non members of Affiliated Riding Clubs who are either under 18 yrs old with horses who have no more than 5 BD points or members aged 18 and over with horses who have no more than 60 BD points. Riders not to have gained FBHS, BHSI, BHSII, BHSAI or pony club A test within the last ten years. Juniors and Seniors will be judged separately as will members and non members. Je: 4 to qualify for Round 2 - 1st placed senior member, 1st placed junior member, 1st placed Senior non-member and 1st placed junior non-member.

Class 4 Novice 25 (2005) *Open to horses with no more than 74 BD Points*

Class 5 Elementary 42 (2008) *Open to horses with no more than 149 BD Points*

Class 6 Combined Elementary 50 (2007) and Medium 63 (2002) *Open to horses with no more than 249 BD points. Same horse and rider combination not to ride in both the Elem and Medium Please state on entry which test*

Riding Test Qualifier: Competitors will need to be members of an Affiliated Riding Club to compete in Round 2. Horses need not be vaccinated against Equine Influenza for round 1, but must have received their first two injections before they can enter Round 2 and the finals at Royal Windsor Horse Show. None of the injections must have been given within the preceding 7 days, including the day of the competition. **The winners at Windsor will be flown out to the Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games 2010 in Lexington to be presented with their trophies!!!**

Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Horses must be four years and over
- It is the responsibility of competitors to familiarise themselves with the appropriate British Dressage Rules for the tests they are riding
- The competition will be run in accordance with BHS Riding Club and BD rules.
- No misuse of the whip or equipment will be allowed.
- Whilst mounted, correct riding attire must be worn. Hats must be correctly fastened and be to a basic standard of PAS015 or BSEN1384.
- The organisers or landowners cannot be held responsible for anything that may happen to competitors, horses, property or spectators in connection with or arising out of the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising out of any incident at the show
- The Judges decision is final
- No refunds will be given after the close of entries and only on receipt of a veterinary or Doctors certificate before the closing date.
- Objections to be made in writing to the secretary with a £15.00 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited should the objection not be sustained.
- It is strongly advised that all competitors ensure they are at least covered by third party liability insurance.
- Entries will be balloted in the event of over subscription and the organisers reserve the right to alter, add or cancel any class and to refuse any entries without stating a reason.
- **Please keep this venue tidy by clearing up before leaving and ensuring no mucking out of trailers or lorries takes place in the car park. If your horse drops, it must be picked up. In addition the hanging up of haynets outside of lorries and trailers is strictly forbidden.**

Health and Safety:

The organisers of WFRC events have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and they must obey the instructions of all officials, stewards and organisers. Any accident, however small, must be reported and recorded at the Secretary's office.
